blades or coxes inside divisions.

Ladies events and medals for Junior events. Spot prizes and Pennants.
Licensed bar open from noon.

All events offered for Open and Women's crews. J13 and younger and New to
Sport crews to row over a shortened course. See separate rules for prize sprint

- Entry fees are **£7** per seat for Senior events, **£5** per seat for Junior events. Coxes free.
- Doubling up is permitted between divisions, no doubling up in the same division.
- All times are approximate and subject to change depending on entries.
- A veteran handicap system will apply at the start in line with British Rowing guidelines.
- Crews will be required to race through the central arch of the Stakeford road bridge, the course will be buoyed to assist steering.
- All entries must be made on the OARA online system by Friday, 13th May 2011, with the sole exceptions of New to Sport entries - see below.
- New to Sport entries can be made by contacting David Wright directly. NTS should be for people competing in their first regatta only. We have two training single sculls (Wintech Explorer 24 boats without floats) which can be used by novice scullers.
- All entry fee payments must be made online via OARA (except NTS).
- No main Regatta entries will be accepted by post, email or telephone.
- The Regatta will make every effort to allow competitors to race in their chosen category, but reserve the right to move crews into higher categories if required.
- The Regatta reserves the right to limit the number of entries in any event, for safety or practical reasons or to withdraw an event where there are insufficient entries.
- No refunds of entry fees will be given after the draw has been made. The draw will appear online at www.cambois-rowing.org on or after Monday, 16th May 2011.
- In the event of the total cancellation of the Regatta, we will endeavour to refund any entry fees paid once unavoidable costs have been covered. In the event of a partial cancellation of the Regatta or for events withdrawn, no refunds will be made.

Cambois Sprint Eights event

For a grand prize of £500 to the winners.

500m downstream, two lane racing.

- Regular regatta rules apply with the following additions.
- A minimum of 4 crews will be required to hold this event.
- Crews must compete in at least one other event in the regular regatta.
- The Sprint eights event will take place after Division 3 at the end of the Regatta.
- Winning crews will be required to stay on the water until an overall victor is found.
- Racing in the eights will be held over a 500m course and will not require passing through Stakeford bridge, unlike the regular Regatta.
- The prize money will be made payable to the successful club only.

Club Eights event.

500m downstream, two lane racing.

- Regular regatta rules apply with the following additions.
- The club eight crew must consist of 2 Juniors, 2 Women, 2 Veterans and 2 Novices.
- The 2 'veterans' should be Masters C or older

Club Quad Dash event.

250m downstream, two lane racing.

- Regular regatta rules apply with the following additions.
- The club quad crew must consist of 1 Junior, 1 Woman, 1 Veteran and 1 Senior.
- The fixed price for the Club Quad Dash is £12 per boat.
